### THE CALL OF THE FIVE LOAVES AND TWO FISH: A MISSIONAL EXPRESSION OF WHOLE PERSON CARE

“Late in the afternoon the Twelve came to him and said, “Send the crowd away so they can go to the surrounding villages and countryside and find food and lodging, because we are in a remote place here.” He replied, “You give them something to eat.” They answered, “We have only five loaves of bread and two fish—unless we go and buy food for all this crowd.”” Luke 9:12-13

In Thailand, Myanmar, India, Egypt, and Nepal, WCCM has long walked this path with our partners, integrating gospel proclamation with compassionate care. We believe the gospel is not detached from life’s realities. It is not an abstract truth floating above suffering. Rather, it is the living hope of Christ entering every layer of human need.

For years, we have labored alongside local partners in evangelism and church planting, as well as in theological education and leadership development. At the same time, we have responded to tangible needs through caring and mercy ministries. This is the natural outworking of Christ’s heart and of our threefold ministry.

### 五餅二魚的呼召 全人關懷的宣教實踐

「日頭快要平西，十二個門徒來對他說：『請叫眾人散開，他們好往四面鄉村裏去借宿找吃的，因為我們這裏是野地。』耶穌說：『你們給他們吃吧！』門徒說：『我們不過有五個餅，兩條魚，若不去為這許多人買食物就不夠。』」路加福音9:12-13

耶穌給門徒出了一道「不可能完成」的題目：你們想辦法為五千人預備晚餐。

在門徒看來，耶穌已經完成了祂的工作——祂教導了群眾，福音已經傳開。接下來，人群的食宿問題似乎不再是他們的責任。況且身處荒野，資源有限，五餅二魚怎可能供應數千人的需要？最理性的做法，似乎是讓眾人自行散去，各自「搵食」。

然而，基督的心腸不止於屬靈需要。祂既憐憫人對福音的渴慕，也顧念他們現實生活的困難。祂要求門徒用手中僅有的資源，成為祝福的起點。這正是主所示範的——全人關懷。



## NEW CHALLENGES AND NEW DIRECTIONS IN NEPAL

In the 2025 to 2026 ministry year, we are taking a further step in Nepal by intentionally integrating church planting, theological education, leadership training, and mercy ministries more closely together. In partnership with local leaders, we are launching two new initiatives.



### 1. Computer Programming and Vocational Training

This program is designed for selected seminary graduates who hold university degrees. It aims to equip them with practical computer skills so they may pursue bi vocational ministry.

Nepal's political and economic conditions have continued to decline in recent years. Employment prospects for young people are bleak, and many are forced to seek work overseas. In the 2024 to 2025 fiscal year alone, approximately 839,266 labor permits were issued for foreign employment. This staggering figure reflects the deep structural challenges facing the nation.

在泰國、緬甸、印度、埃及、尼泊爾等地，普差會多年來秉承福音與關懷並行的事工方向，與當地夥伴同心努力，在佈道植堂、神學教育、領袖培訓上同行，也在慈惠和關懷上回應實際需要。因為我們深信，福音不是抽離生活的真理，而是臨到生命每一層面的盼望。

## 尼泊爾的新挑戰與新方向

在2025/2026年度，我們更進一步，針對尼泊爾的實際需要，將佈道植堂、神學與領袖訓練、慈惠與關懷更緊密結合，與當地夥伴開展兩項新事工：

### 一、電腦程式培訓班

為部分具大學學歷的神學畢業生提供電腦技能訓練，幫助他們有帶職事奉的新出路。





Many young believers who sense a call to full time ministry are compelled to abandon that calling due to financial pressure. After graduation, numerous churches are unable to provide even a basic stipend, let alone support church planting or mission outreach. In rural and mountainous areas, vocational options are often limited to subsistence farming or livestock raising. In cities, opportunities are usually confined to low skilled labor.



We believe that foundational computer and programming training can open new pathways. With marketable digital skills, these called and gifted workers may sustain themselves while continuing to serve faithfully. After one year of pilot testing and evaluation, we are encouraged by the results and are preparing to expand this initiative in 2026.

## 2. Scholarship Program for Pastors' Children

While younger graduates struggle with livelihood, senior pastors and ministry workers face another burden: the education of their children.

支援貧困傳道人家庭子女的教育需要。

尼泊爾近年政治與經濟持續下滑，年輕人就業前景黯淡，大量青年被迫出國謀生。在2024/25財政年度，尼泊爾共發出約839,266份海外勞工工作許可證。這個驚人的數字，正反映整個國家的現況。

許多有心全時間事奉的年輕人，因家庭經濟壓力而不得不放棄呼召。神學院畢業後，不少教會無力支付薪酬，更遑論支持植堂與宣教工作。即使想帶職事奉，在農村及山區，祇能靠耕種和飼養牲畜；在城市中也往往只能被迫爭取低技能勞力工作，機會極其有限。

我們相信，基礎的電腦與程式訓練，可以為這些有呼召卻經濟拮据的傳道人，開闢新的帶職（事奉）可能。經過一年的試驗與評估，我們有信心在2026年進一步擴展這項計劃。

## 同工家庭的隱憂

另一方面，年資較深的傳道同工，卻面對另一種壓力，就是子女教育。

有些家庭連基本學費與校服費都難以負擔；有些事奉地區缺乏學校或師資，孩子需要送往鄰區就讀，甚至寄宿他處；部分家庭被迫就讀私校，更是百上加斤！

對我們而言，每月15美元或許不算甚麼；但對這些忠心事奉的教牧家庭，卻是一份實質而溫暖的支持。

Some families cannot afford basic tuition or school uniforms. In certain ministry locations, there are no adequate schools nearby, requiring children to travel long distances or board away from home. Others are compelled to enroll in private schools due to the absence of viable alternatives, increasing financial strain significantly.

For many of us, fifteen dollars a month may seem modest. For these faithful ministry families, it is meaningful and deeply reassuring support.

We therefore plan to assist 100 under resourced pastoral families in Nepal, helping to ease their educational burdens. Our hope is that by caring for their children, we free these servants of God to focus more fully on their calling, without constant anxiety over daily needs.

This is more than financial assistance. It is walking alongside them in whole person care. It is loving not only the servant, but also the servant's family. It is strengthening the body of Christ so that the gospel may travel farther and deeper.

### FROM FIVE LOAVES TO MANY LIVES

When Jesus said, "You give them something to eat," He was not merely testing His disciples. He was inviting them into His compassion. What they offered seemed insufficient. But placed in His hands, it became abundance.

Today, we may feel that our resources are limited. Yet the Lord still calls us to offer what we have. As we place our five loaves and two fish before Him, He multiplies them for His glory.

May we continue to respond to His call with faith, trusting that in His hands, even the smallest offering can become a blessing to thousands.

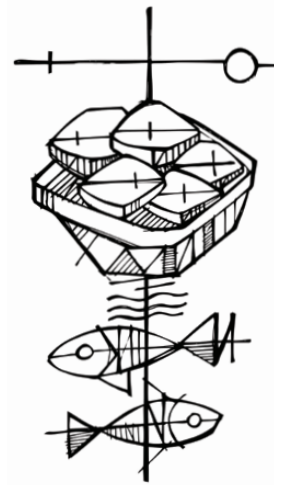

On September 28, 2025, WCCM celebrated its 30th anniversary with a banquet at NBC Restaurant in Monterey Park, attracting over 300 attendees. The evening was filled with meaningful exchanges and fellowship, creating a joyful atmosphere for all.

WCCM has focused on the Gospel's work in Nepal since its founding thirty years ago. Our late president, Rev. Fred Cheung, made multiple trips to support local ministries despite his illness. His wife, Dr. Freda Cheung, continued this mission after him. Under Rev. Stanley Kwong's leadership, connections with local churches and seminaries strengthened, leading to two to three visits to Nepal each year.

As a missionary organization that operates without denominational support, the fact that WCCM has functioned smoothly for thirty years is truly a miracle. However, that is now behind us; we move forward to claim what is ours, because Christ Jesus has claimed us as His own. As Paul said, "I do not consider that I have made it my own; but one thing I do, forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:13-14)

# LET US PUT THE PAST THIRTY YEARS BEHIND US AND FOCUS ON THE CHALLENGES THAT LIE AHEAD







In October 2025, WCCM President Rev. Stanley Kwong visited New Zealand to engage with local churches and workers. He led a leadership training conference. Over 60 Nepali church leaders from India, Nepal, Australia, the US, Canada, and New Zealand gathered in New Zealand for a leadership conference. They collaborated on strategies to connect with Nepali communities globally and explore opportunities to share their faith. Together, they are examining how Nepali Christian communities residing abroad can actively participate in global missions.

The WCCM mission team visited the children's ministry of local churches in Nepal.

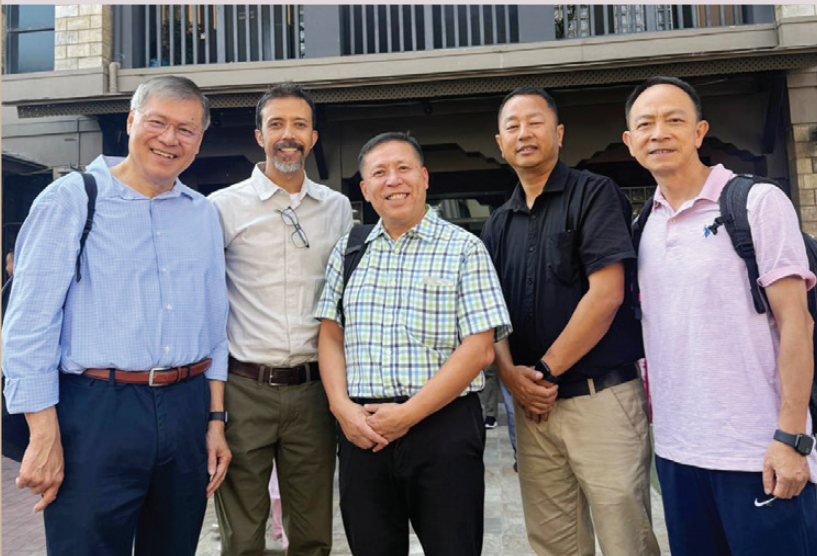

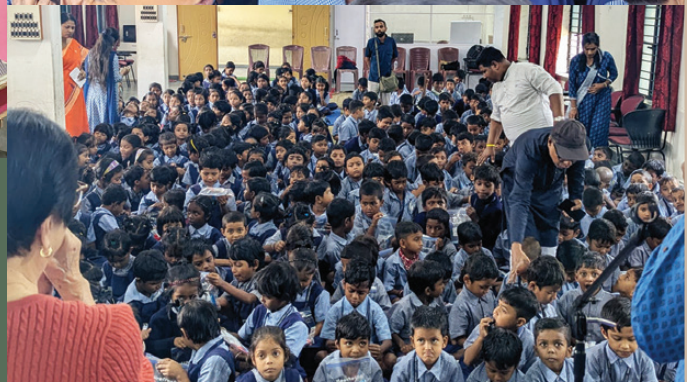
The WCCM mission team visited the work of local partner Living Hope and Pastor Joshua. The team visited the medical outreach service and took a group photo at the newly completed clinic.
